- 4) **Public Input on Future Improvements to Crivitz Community Veteran's Park:** A park survey had been distributed to the community in the weeks prior to the hearing. Some of the responses to the survey were discussed and comments from the public included the following suggestions for improvements to the park:

Octoball course by pavilion	Grills by pavilion
Add kitchen & bathroom to pavilion	Add concession area to pavilion
More & Handicapped bathrooms	More trash containers in park
Walking paths suitable for wheelchairs	Lighting all around park - solar or LED
Sledding hill	Covered band stand
Upgrade electrical service to pavilion	Sidewalks on Louisa & Hall at ball field
Splash Pad	Secured benches & picnic tables

Those present indicated their priorities were a covered bandstand, additional lighting, a splash pad, pavilion concessions, more bathrooms and parking. All others mentioned were also well received.

Those present agreed that the name of the park should be changed, as it causes confusion to visitors because there are 2 other Veteran's Parks in Marinette County. It was agreed that the new name should honor Veterans and military service. The Village will look for alternate names.
