Board of Review (BOR) Called to Order at 6pm

- 1. Confirmation of appropriate BOR and Open Meetings Notices.
- 2. Select a Chairperson for BOR: Michael Strandt and Amy Grandaw were nominated, Amy Grandaw won 4 to 0.
- 3. Select a BOR Vice-Chairperson: Michael Strandt nominated and won 4 to 0.
- 4. Verify that at least one BOR member has met the mandatory training requirement.
- 5. Verify that the Village has an ordinance for the confidentiality of income and expense information provided to the Assessor under state law (Wis. Stat. 70.47(7) (af)).
- 6. Review of new laws: No new laws effecting assessing or board of review.
- 7. Adoption of amendment to policy regarding the procedure for sworn telephone testimony and sworn written testimony: Village of Crivitz has already adopted this policy.
- 8. Adoption of policy regarding the procedure for waiver of BOR hearing requests: Village of Crivitz has already adopted this policy.
- 9. Filing and summary of Annual Assessment Report by Assessor's Office: bypassed no longer required
- 10. Receive the Assessment Roll and sworn statements from the Clerk.
- 11. Review the Assessment Roll and perform statutory duties:
  - a. Examine the roll,
  - b. Correct description or calculation errors,
  - c. Add omitted property, and
  - d. Eliminate double assessed property.
- 12. Discussion/Action Certify all corrections of error under state law (Wis. Stat. 70.43): Certified by Assessor Ryan Raatz.
- 13. Discussion/Action Verify with the Assessor that open book changes are included in the assessment roll: None.
- 14. Allow taxpayers to examine assessment data: no taxpayer present

  - a. Waivers of the required 48-hour notice of intent to file an objection when there is good cause: bypass.
  - b. Requests for waiver of the BOR hearing allowing the property owner an appeal directly to the circuit court: bypass.
